Comings and Goings—Member Events

- We have been busy this winter and currently have three projects underway. All of them are very much needed.
 - ⇒ Windows — Art Glass is currently repairing/restoring four windows on the chapel. They have completed about half of the project. The weather and illness have delayed the completion of the project. This is phase one. We will continue to restore the remaining windows in phases. This is a very expensive (but much needed and very important) project.
 - ⇒ PA System — We are working with Dean Bader and a colleague of his to upgrade our PA system. This is much overdue. The project is expected to be completed in six months.
 - ⇒ Marquee — We are working with Brewer Graphics on a marquee. The marquee will be placed at the bottom of the church terraces and display upcoming masses and other events.

Much Thanks to our members and supporters. Without all of you, these improvements would not be possible.
- The Christmas Country Church Tour was held on December 16 and 17th. Our chapel was one of 31 churches that participated. The tour extended from Cape County, Perry County and now Sainte Genevieve County and Kaskaskia, Illinois. Over 400 steeple chasers toured our beautifully decorated chapel. We had cookies and rosaries for donation. We had ornaments for sale for five dollars each. The ornament was a beautiful picture of our school house. Rosaries and ornaments are still available. - Father Hayes celebrated our Christmas Eve mass to a full church! The beautifully decorated church set the tone for our outstanding musicians. The musicians brought tears to our eyes and were given a round of applause after mass. Daniel Kuenzel played the organ, Abby Englemann was the vocalist, and Bryce Trollinger played the trumpet. Baby Jesus was carried and placed in the manger by Brady and Dylan Nancy Shuh. Poinsettias were offered to all who made a donation to help purchase them.
- A project is underway to reproduce the 1967 “What’s Cookin’ in Saint Marys, Missouri” cookbook compiled by the St. Ann’s Sodality of the Immaculate Conception Parish. It will be reproduced as closely to the original version as possible. We are uncertain of the cost yet, but if you would like to purchase or want more information, please contact Kim Breig.
- In our effort to begin the cleanup needed to our 94 year old rectory, a very successful estate sale was held in December 2021. Open to SMICCCPS members the first hour on sale day, it quickly became old home week as many of you shopped for treasures and walked away with some interesting pieces of our 167 year history. By 5:30 we had sold just about everything and what was left we donated to Catholic Charities in our area. Thank you for helping us raise as much as we could. The money went toward our construction fund. Our thanks to Damien Seek for his work in helping us clear out and recycle all the electronics and junk after the sale.
