We cannot thank you enough for your spiritual and financial support. We encourage your ideas and help in maintaining this beautiful Chapel on the hill.



Did you know that our church clock is a very rare treasure?

Our Church Tower Clock was made by the A. E. Pollhans Company, of St. Louis, and has a manufacture plate with a date of January, 1914. With gears, rods, and levers, the weights turn gears and drive levers to keep time, drive the hands on the clock faces on the steeple, and ring the bells. The “chime” rings the quarter hours and the “strike” rings the hour.

We are indebted to James Willman, clockmaker and collector, for assisting us in learning about how to operate and service the clock.
